Be an informed voter before the June primary and come to University City High School auditorium on May 14th at 6:30 p.m. to meet all five candidates for City Attorney: incumbent Mike Aguirre, and challengers Judge Jan Goldsmith, Attorney Amy Lepine, Councilman Brian Maienschein, and Council President Scott Peters. The candidate forum will be moderated by the League of Women Voters, so we can expect an evening of civil discourse.

The current agenda will include your challenging written questions taken from the audience beginning at 6:30 p.m. hopefully reflecting citizens' concerns regarding the legal operation and running of City government. After a brief UCCA welcome, the League of Women Voters Moderator will explain the forum format and introduce the five candidates. Each candidate will have a two-minute opening statement. The candidates will give a one-minute response to the questions from the audience. After a period of questions and answers for an hour, each candidate will give a two-minute closing statement.

Ballot Decisions in June.....

At the April UCCA board meeting, Adrian Kwiatkowski, District 8 nominee of Charter Review Committee, gave a short presentation on A,B, and C Prospositions. He supports them.

Proposition A: Exempts public safety from managed competition. It amends City charter to exempt police, firefighters, And lifeguards from managed competition

Proposition B: Voters will decide the strong mayor and expanded City Council. It ensures a June 2010 election to decide three related matters: if strong mayor form of government should be permanent, adding one council seat to break ties, and increasing city council votes required to override a mayoral veto if ninth council seat is added.

Proposition C: Independent auditor
And budget analyst. City auditor
becomes independent office, nominated
by mayor and approved by City
Council., and reports to audit committee
Auditor cannot be fired for cause, only if
recommended by audit committee, subject
to two-thirds approval of City Council.
Prop C also makes permanent the office of
Independent Budget Analyst. This position
will expire in 2010 unless city charter is
changed
