Are you ready? University City community's biggest event – 4th of July Celebration – is almost here for its 26th time for all the residents and friends of University City to enjoy. Join fellow community members, families and friends for a day of celebration and fun.

The highly popular 5k Race & 1 Mile Fun Run/Walk will be back this year, thanks to dedicated volunteer team members of the Planning Committee who will continue the tradition this year after a successful comeback last year. Registration for the race is open. Please go to www.universitycitynews.org/uc-4th-of-july/ to get pre-registered. You can also pre-register by mail before June 15 or register **Thursday July 3, 6-7 PM**, at **Standley Recreation Center** or on event day, **Friday July 4th from 6:30 -7:45 AM** at **Standley Recreation Park, 3585 Governor Drive, San Diego, CA 92122**

The Run Courses start and finish in the grass field east of Swanson Pool at Standley Park. The 5-kilometer (3.1 mile) course is two counter-clockwise loops around Standley Park and Standley Middle School along sidewalks, paved areas, and grass athletic fields. The 1 mile course is a loop around Standley Middle School.

Your entry/registration includes:

- Admission to Pancake Breakfast (8:00 am – 10:00 am)
- Awards to top finishers in age groups of 5K race
- Finisher medal for participants under 18
- Water and snacks at finish line
- Water bottle (guaranteed for early registrants)
- Stay for activities and music throughout the day
