#### <u>Genesee Avenue will be closed from La Jolla Village Drive to Nobel Drive from April 16<sup>th</sup> at 10 PM to April 18<sup>th</sup> at 5 AM. In addition, pre- and post-demolition activities will occur from April 11<sup>th</sup> to May 4<sup>th</sup>.</u>

### April 11<sup>th</sup> – April 15<sup>th</sup> – Preparation for Bridge Demolition

- Activities will include cutting and capping irrigation lines, protecting the main line and control valves/wiring, and installing temporary fencing.
- Tree and vegetation removal will occur from 7:00 AM to 10:00 AM daily.
- Work will occur in the parking lot adjacent to the pedestrian bridge during morning hours.

## Saturday, April 16<sup>th</sup> at 10 PM – Monday, April 18<sup>th</sup> at 5 AM – Bridge Demolition

- Genesee Avenue will be closed to thru traffic from Nobel Drive to La Jolla Village Drive.
- Access via Esplanade will be prohibited from April 16<sup>th</sup> through April 18<sup>th</sup>.
- The Costa Verde shopping center entrance on Genesee Avenue will be closed and the exit will be restricted to right-turn only.
- The Genesee Avenue exit toward Nobel Drive will be right-turn only.

## April 19<sup>th</sup> – May 4<sup>th</sup> – Post Demolition

 Activities will include reestablishing grade and irrigation line connections, installing new landscaping and trees, and removing temporary fencing.
