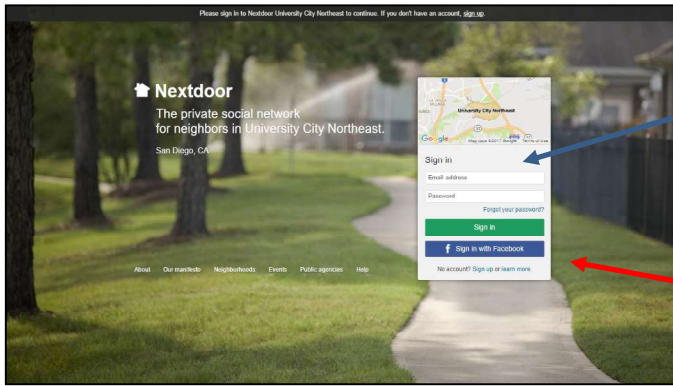

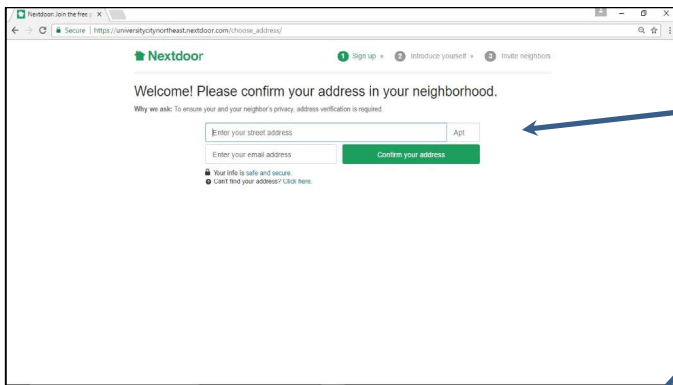
## How to create and customize your Nextdoor account:

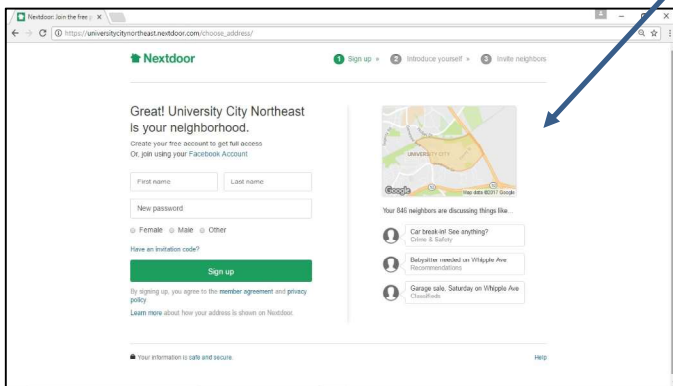


**Existing Account?** You can sign in with either Facebook **OR** your email address.

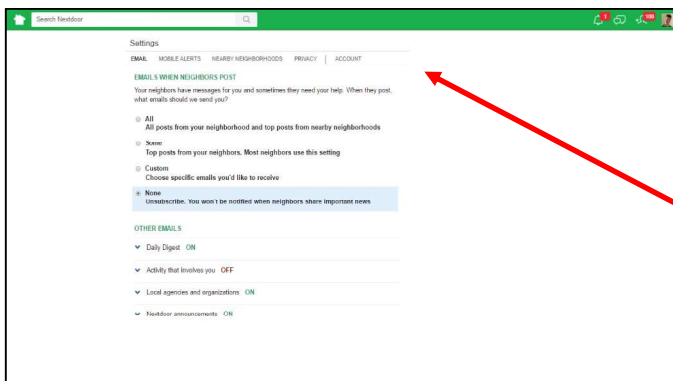
**Address verification page:** To ensure your and your neighbor's privacy, address verification is required.
