



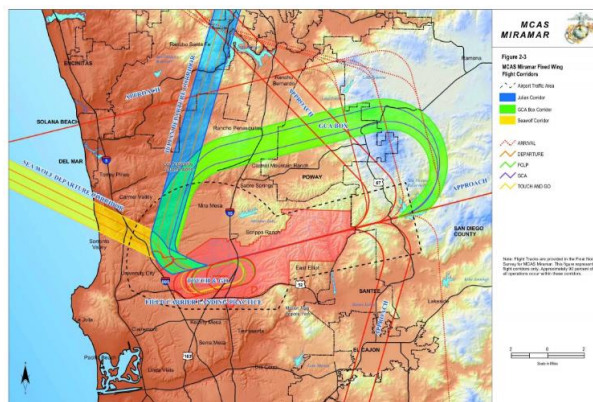

It is my hope that we can identify a resolution that supports the Marine Corps mission while taking into consideration the quality of life for residents in University City.

Currently, University City is updating their community plan. This plan update has provided a public forum for community concerns to be voiced and heard. One of the most common issues raised is noise and safety concerns related to the training flights of MCAS Miramar's fleet. It is my sincere belief that most these concerns could be addressed if the pilots adhered to the flight corridors illustrated below in the DoD's AICUZ land use planning document:



The patterns depicted in the AICUZ avoid the direct overhead flights of most residences in University City. Therefore, I am requesting that Miramar Air Traffic Controllers and our brave pilots avoid deviations from the existing FAA and DoD flight procedures. Thank you for your service to our nation and for your time and attention to this matter. I look forward to hearing from you on how we can work together to support both the Marine Corps and the residents of University City.
