Selected CWPP Sections (guidelines for projects discussion)

- Community Engagement & Education – build awareness in preventing loss of property & life
- Structural Hardening – steps to protect homes and other structures
- Defensible Space – creating a buffer between buildings and the grass, trees, shrubs and other wildland areas
- Fuels Treatment – efforts to treat and manage combustible materials (including roadside thinning, fuel breaks, diseased/dead tree removal, forest health)
- Evacuation Planning – identify key corridors in and out , temporary refuge areas, PACE system (primary, alternate, contingency, and emergency)
