






Aviation Activity Forecast

Outdated Terminal 1 results in sub-optimal passenger experience








Airport Development Plan Goals

- Passenger Terminal Facilities


 Efficiently accommodate future activity levels




Frequent Community Questions

Won't the new Terminal 1 increase the number of flights, since there will be 11 additional gates?

No, simulation modeling shows that the "No Build" Alternative can accommodate all of the scheduled flights in 2035.

Why doesn't the Airport Authority require quieter aircraft or direct flights away from neighborhoods?

The FAA has sole control over aircrafts and their flight paths in order to ensure safe and efficient operations.

Frequent Community Questions

Why doesn't the Airport Authority evaluate the impacts of aircraft on health (noise, air quality, etc.)?

There have been multiple studies on the impacts of aircraft operations on health and more studies are emerging (discussed & evaluated in EIR). Replacing Terminal 1 actually reduces emissions compared to the "No Build" scenario.
