


What is the Coastal Rail Trail Project?

- Regional multi-use trail, Project Study Report (PSR) approved 2000
- Connects Oceanside, Carlsbad, Encinitas, Solana Beach, Del Mar, and San Diego



Coastal Rail Trail Goals

- Locate within railroad ROW or parallel heavily traveled roadways
- Provide a direct north-south connection following routes used by pedestrians and bicycles
- Meet state and federal standards and intent of ADA
- Where desirable, provide separate treadways for pedestrians and wheeled users
- Design road crossings to maximize safety and convenience

City's Coastal Rail Trail Project

- This project is proposing a One-Way Cycle Track (Class IV) along both sides of Gilman Drive.
- The project proposes the following improvements:
 - A protected North and South bound one-way cycle track (Class IV)
 - o A continuous sidewalk along the west side
 - o Retains street parking
 - o Street Lighting
- The project connects in the north to UCSD and Genesee Avenue Class I Bikeway currently under construction by Caltrans.
- The project connects in the south to the existing Class I bikeway under I-5 and SANDAG's future Class I Bikeway along Santa Fe Street.







Proposed Conditions








