

- Connects Oceanside, Carlsbad, Encinitas, Solana Beach, Del Mar, and San Diego

- Expand transportation choices encourage more people to choose to ride
















The City of San Diego Coastal Rail Trail – Gilman Drive Project









Coastal Rail Trail – Gilman Dr Project

- This project is proposing a One-Way Cycle Track (Class IV) along both sides of Gilman Drive.
- The project proposes the following improvements:
 - A protected North and South bound one-way cycle track (Class IV)
 - o A continuous sidewalk along the west side
 - Retains street parking
 - New Street Lighting
 - o Traffic Signal Modifications and new Signal at La Jolla Village Drive
- The project connects in the north to UCSD and the Genesee Avenue Class I Bikeway.
- The project connects in the south to the existing Class I bikeway under I-5 and SANDAG's Class I Bikeway along Santa Fe Street.













Traffic Improvements at I-5 (SB)

































Coastal Rail Trail Project at Driveways










Traffic Improvements at Via Alicante











