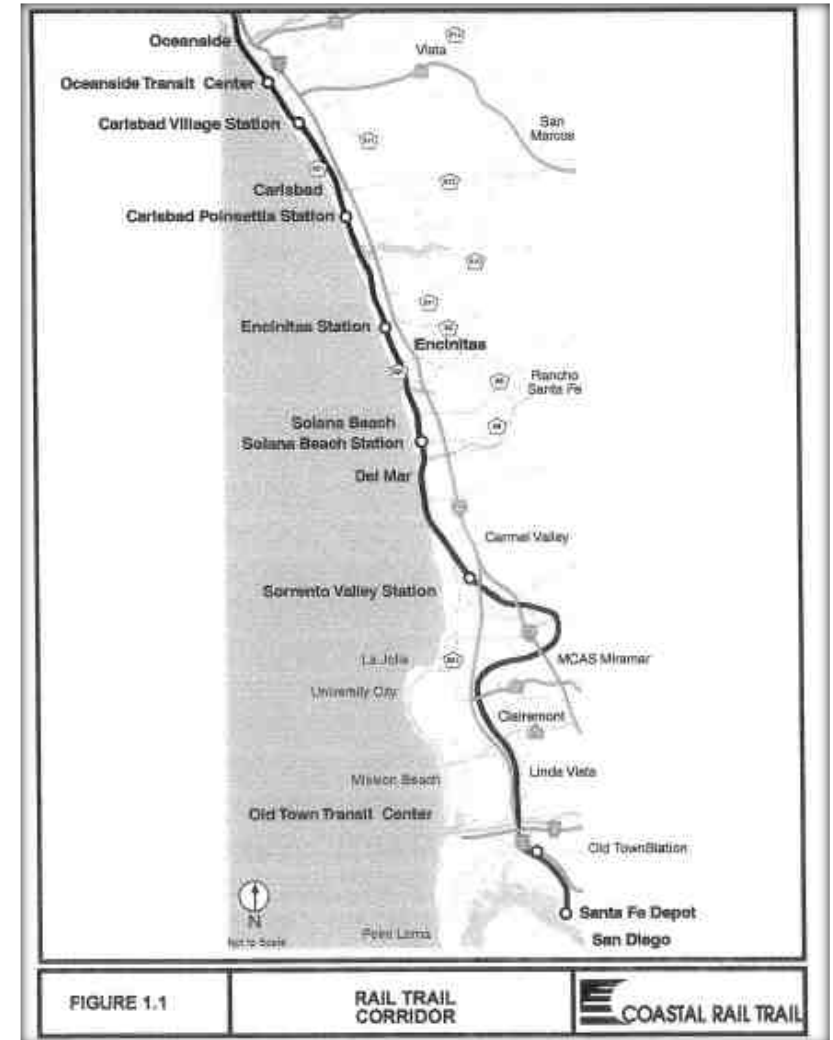

The Coastal Rail Trail Regional Project

- Regional multi-use trail, Project Study Report (PSR) approved 2000
- Connects Oceanside, Carlsbad, Encinitas, Solana Beach, Del Mar, and San Diego



Active Transportation Goals

- Connect neighborhoods, regions & activity centers
- Enhance neighborhood character
- Improve quality of life and public health
- Expand transportation choices – encourage more people to choose to ride

Coastal Rail Trail – Gilman Dr Project

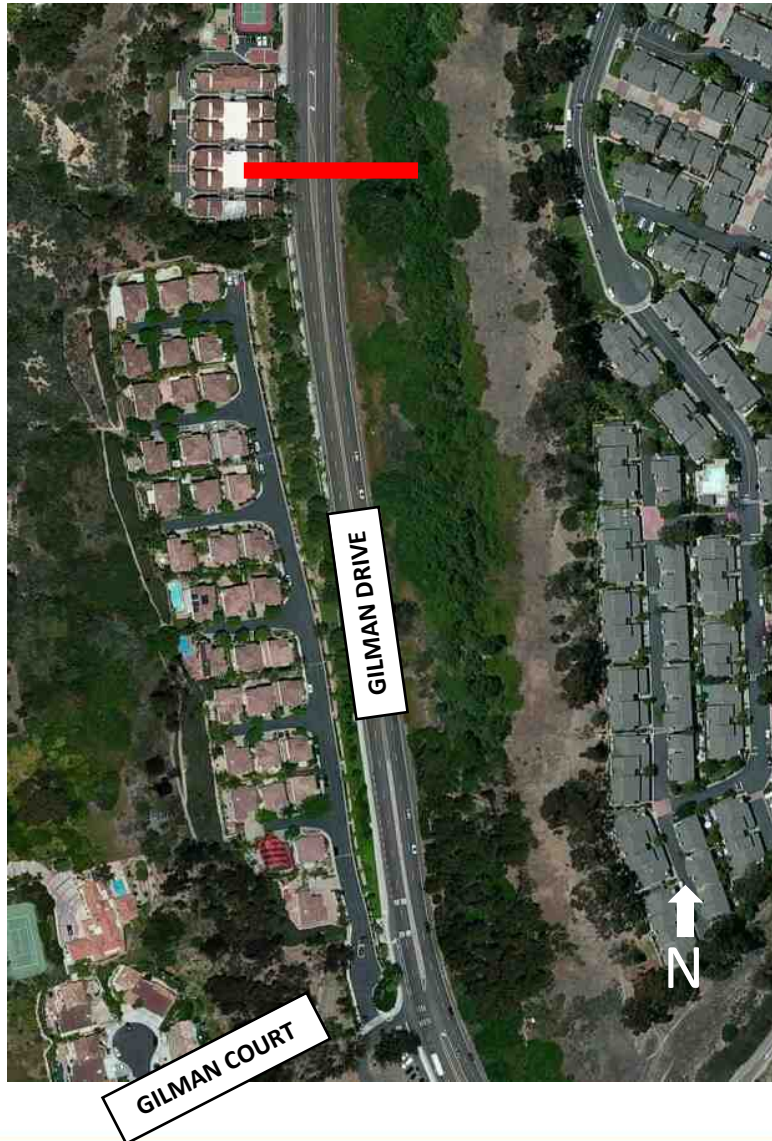
- This project is proposing a One-Way Cycle Track (Class IV) along both sides of Gilman Drive.
- The project proposes the following improvements:
 - A protected North and South bound one-way cycle track (Class IV)
 - A continuous sidewalk along the west side
 - Retains street parking
 - New Street Lighting
 - Traffic Signal Modifications and new Signal at La Jolla Village Drive
- The project connects in the north to UCSD and the Genesee Avenue Class I Bikeway.
- The project connects in the south to the existing Class I bikeway under I-5 and SANDAG's Class I Bikeway along Santa Fe Street.



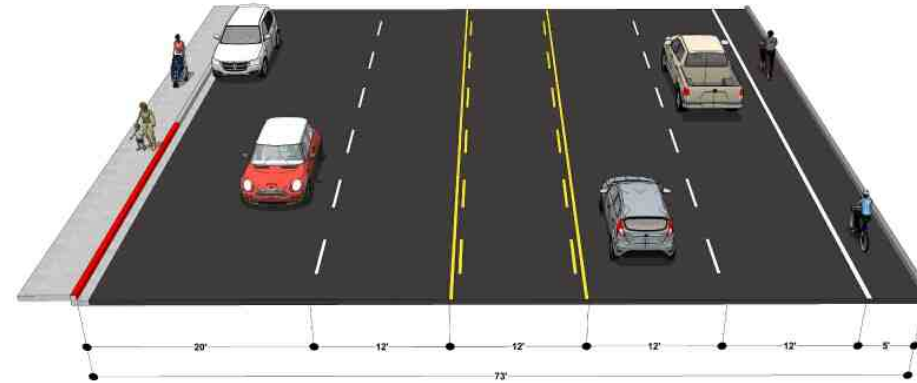

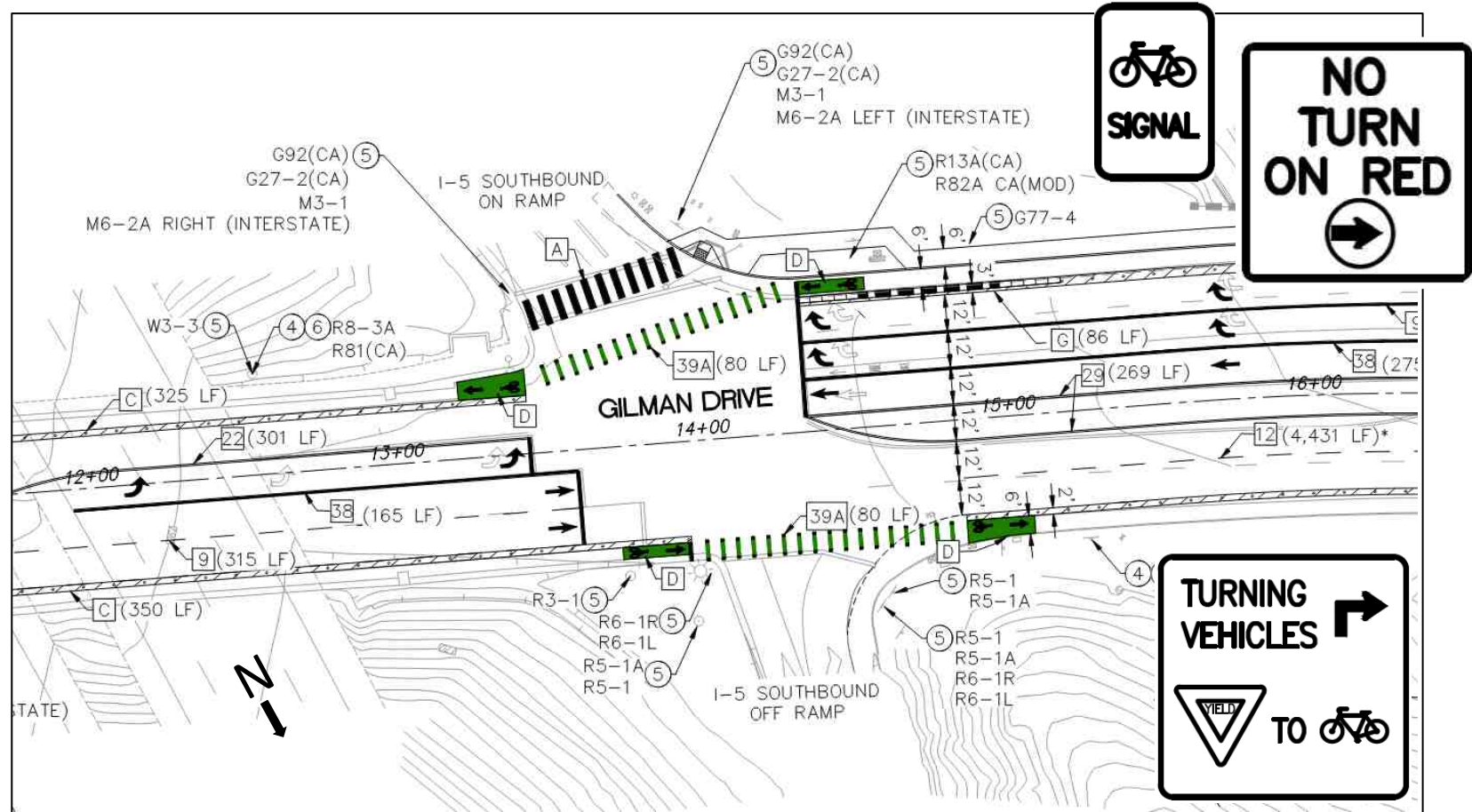

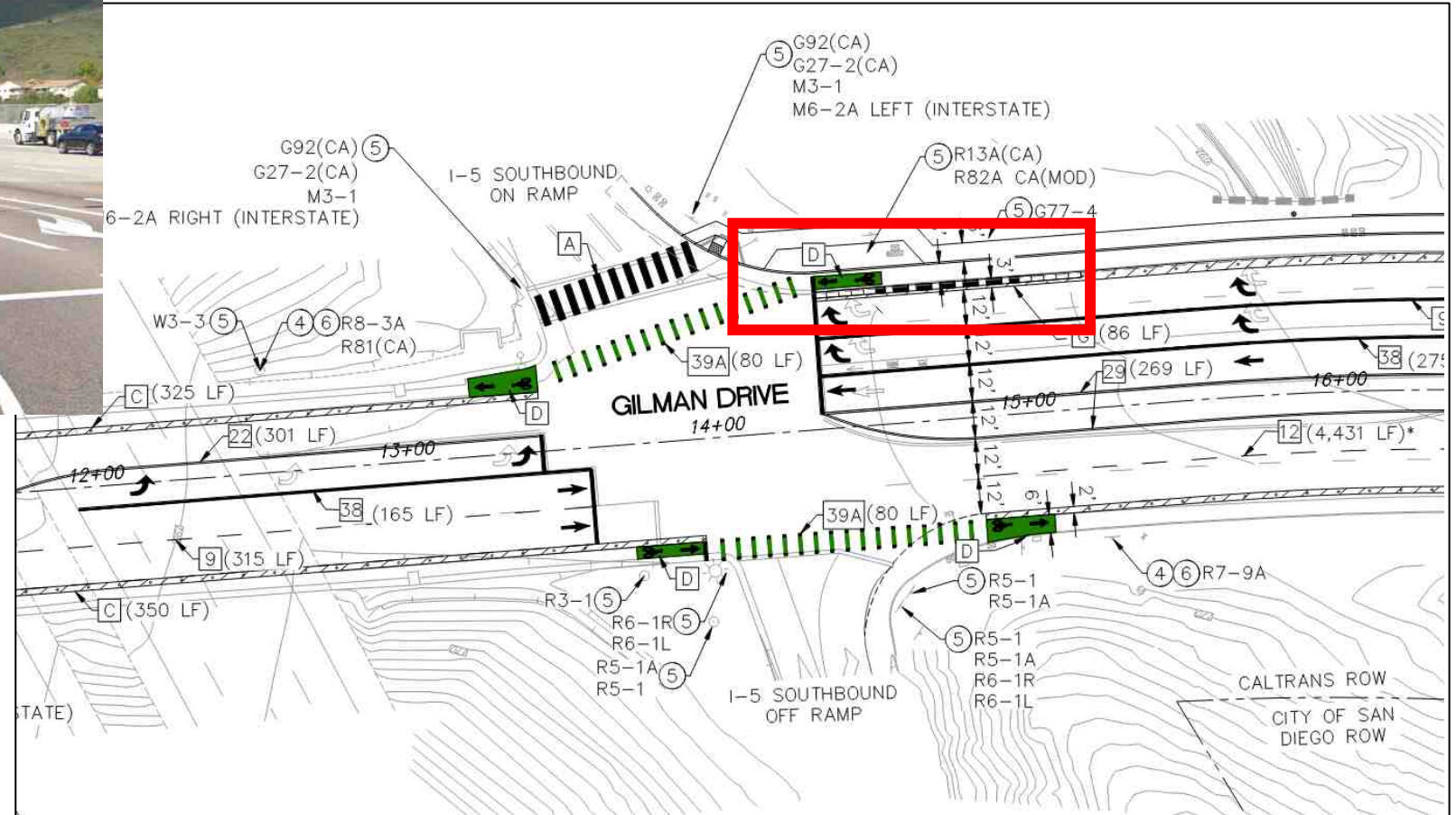

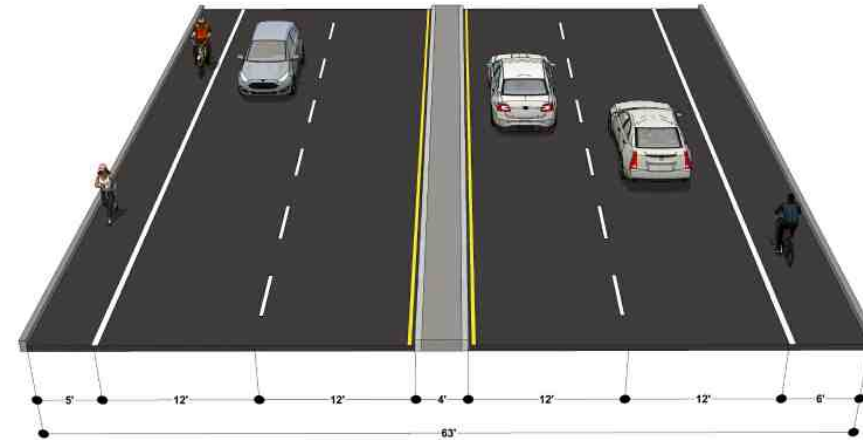
Example of Raised Concrete Barrier – SR- 56 over I-15



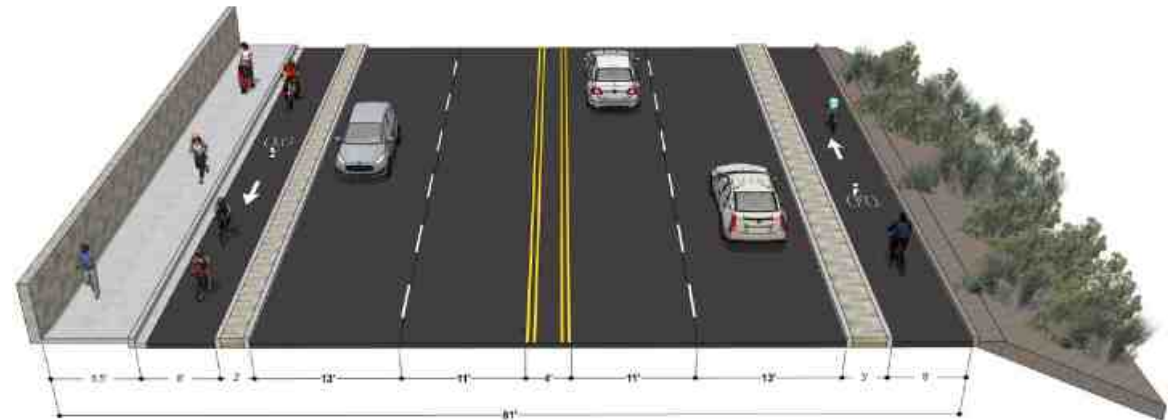

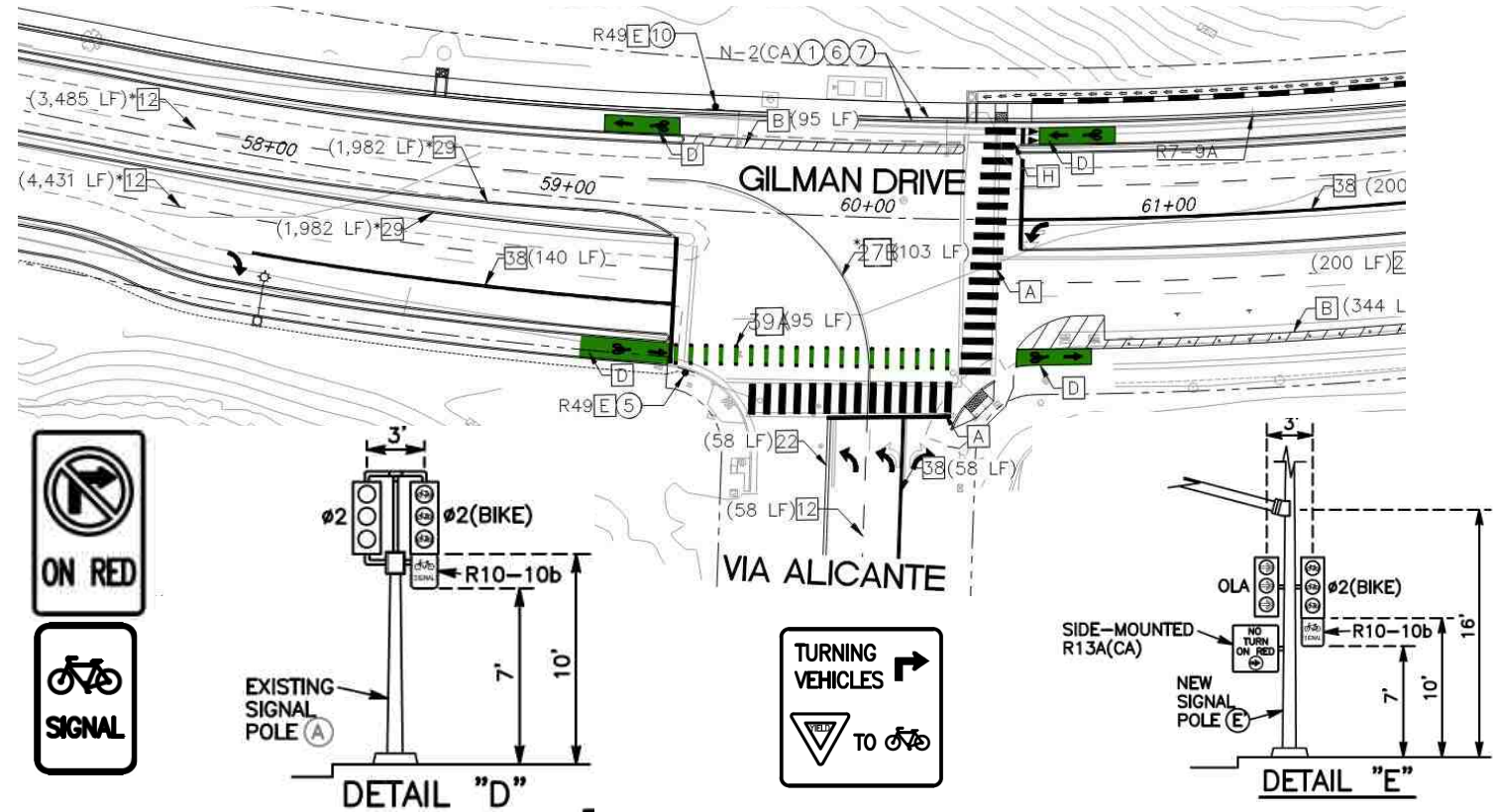

Coastal Rail Trail Project at Driveways



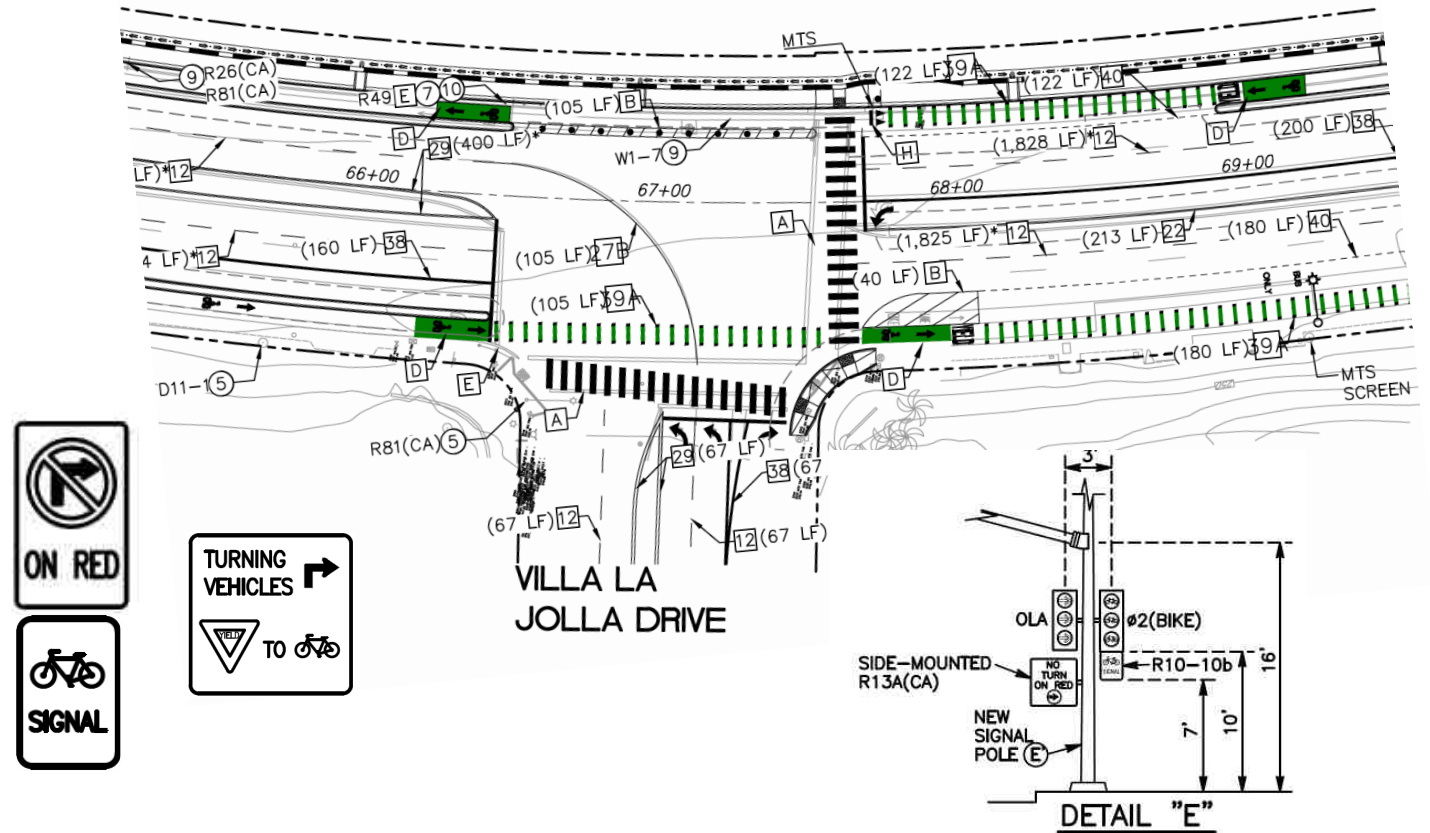

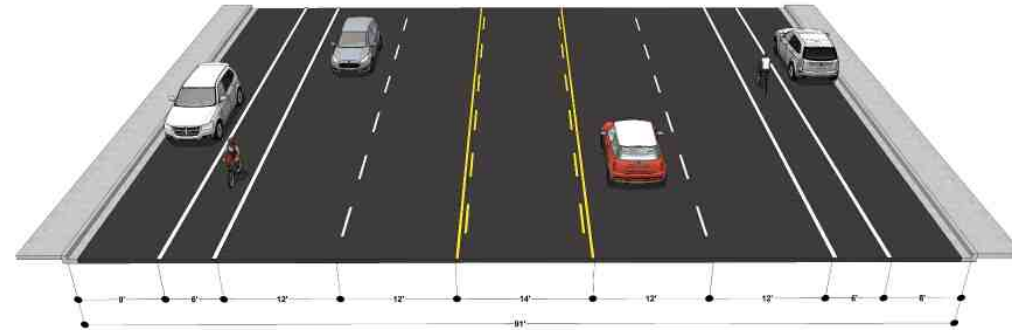

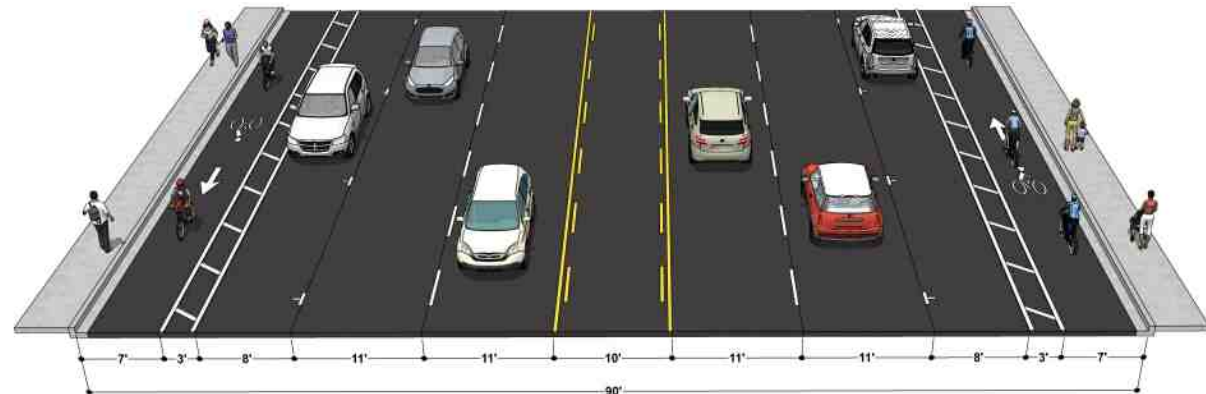
Traffic Improvements at Villa la Jolla Dr

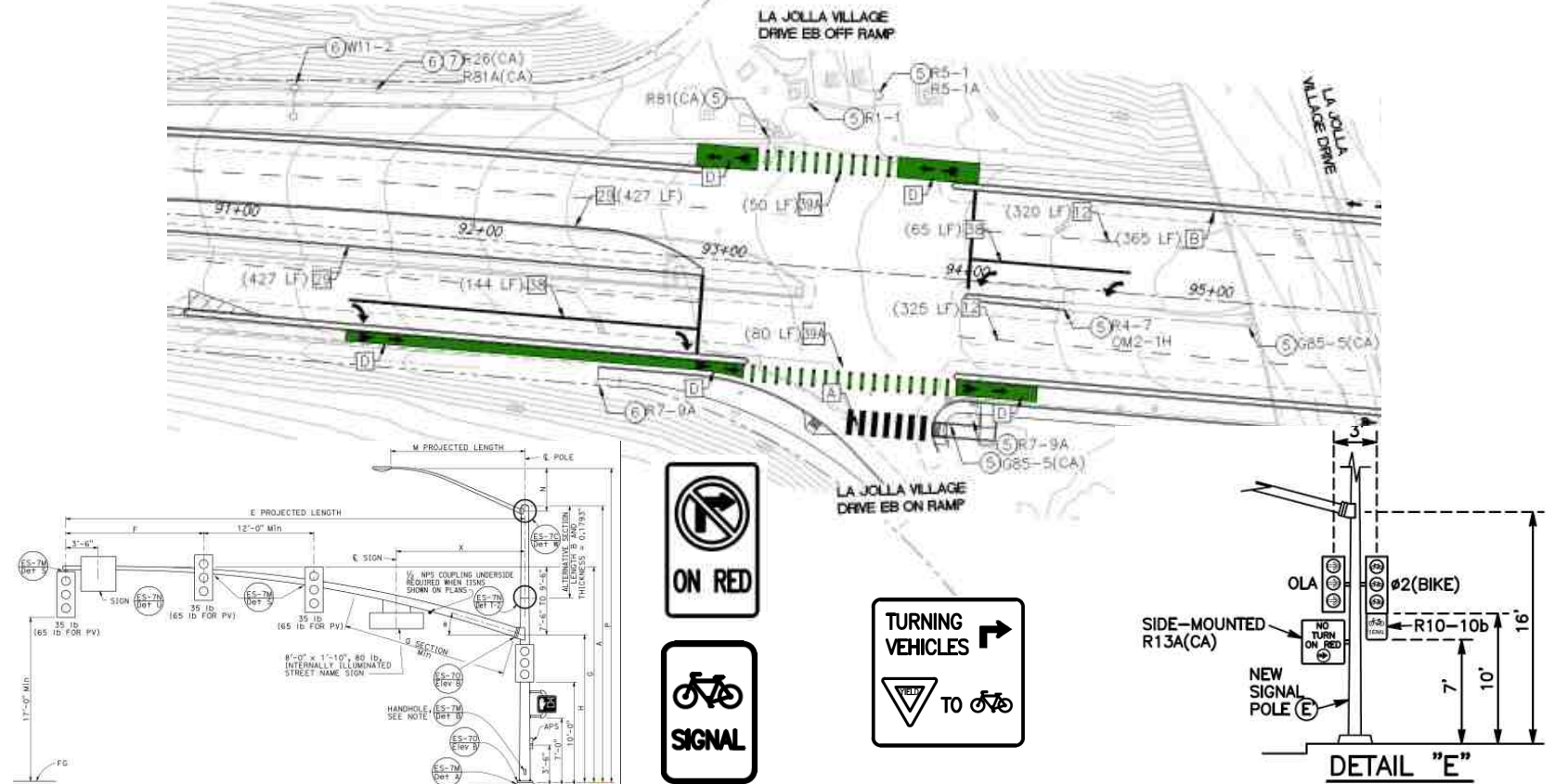
