




Fire Safe Councils (FSCs) help to keep San Diego "Fire Safe".




Local Fire Safe Councils know the unique challenges our communities face.

Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP)




CWPP is developed collaboratively by residents and community members with the City of San Diego Fire-Rescue Department and federal, state, county, and the City of San Diego management agencies.

- **Does** represent a blueprint for fire **prevention** and **preparedness** at the neighborhood level.
- **Does** organize a community's efforts to protect itself against both structure and wildfire.
- Does empower residents and community members to move in a cohesive, common direction.
- Does not propose activities or projects subject to CEQA.

Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP)

CWPP template was developed by SD County Fire Safe Council.

- Sections include:
 - Community overview, fire history and resources
 - Community engagement and education
 - Structural hardening and defensible space
 - Fuels treatment and evacuation planning
 - Other mitigation and preparedness projects
 - Maps, meeting tracking, and CWPP approval documentation



The Fire Safe Council of San Diego County is the umbrella for local Fire Safe Councils.


