
Solution Morena Northern Pipeline & Tunnels

- Two pipelines will start at Genesee/SR-52 and continue through UC to the NCWRP
 - One transports wastewater to the NCWRP (N)
 - One transports brine from the NCPWF to PLWTP (S)
- Three short tunnels (approx. 1,000 ft. long) at SR-52, Rose Canyon (Genesee), and I-805

SD Looking Ahead

- Continued pipe installation and pipeline work on Executive Drive
- Start daytime pipe installation on Towne Center Drive between La Jolla Village Drive and Executive Drive
- Annual Holiday Shopping Moratorium applies to La Jolla Village Drive and Towne Centre Drive, south of La Jolla Village Drive
 - No work will occur in this section from Thanksgiving Day-New Years Day
- Ongoing coordination with businesses and HOAs

- 24-hour traffic control using k-rail
- Traffic will be diverted to the southbound lanes of Genesee Ave. during construction

SD What You Can Expect

- Traffic control for public safety via "block by block" road closures or lane reductions will be in place
 - Access for residents, businesses and emergency vehicles will be maintained; some delays expected
- Construction equipment and material staging areas along the alignment; staging areas will move along with construction
- Possible intersection closures due to weekend work
- Posted detours for bike lanes, sidewalks and trails
- No parking in construction zones
- Impacts such as noise, dust, bright lights and construction vehicle traffic during work hours
